

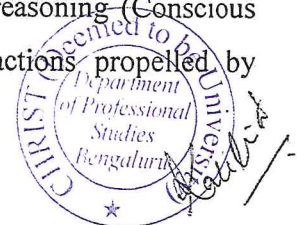
20) Workshop based on leadership skill development for faculty members: **Discovering the leader in you**

The Department of Professional Studies conducted a one-day Faculty Development Programme in the form of a workshop on **Leadership skills: Discovering the Leader in You**, on 13 March ,2020 at Room 119, from 10 Am onwards. The Resource Person of the programme was Professor Mathew Verghese, and the chief guest was the Head of the Department, Dr Kavitha Desai. Attended by all the Faculty members, the programme was organized successfully.

Professor Mathew Verghese is a chartered Accountant, Cost Accountant, Certified Public Accountant, Certified Internal auditor, Certified Control Self-Assessment Professional and Associate in Risk Management. Having started his career at Deloitte in external affairs, Prof Mathew has had subsequent stints at various companies including shipping, construction, and manufacturing industries in the domain of Finance, internal audit and Risk management. After working for more than two decades in the corporate sector, Professor Mathew moved into the academia and is presently associated with the Department of Professional Studies, at Christ University. An award winning Public Speaker and consultant for Proctor Gallagher Institute, USA, He's also a distinguished Toastmaster as well as the reigning district champion of Kerala and Karnataka in both evaluation and table topics speech categories.



The session began with the inaugural and welcome address by Dr.Padmini followed by Professor Mathews interactive and lively session on Leadership skills. Professor Mathew started off by busting and deconstructing popular leadership myths.Moving on his lecture spurred the audiences own thoughts on what it takes to be a great leader, highlighting the distinct traits of a leader and underscoring the importance of Discipline, Decision, Trust, Commitment, Accountability,Focus, Self-image and far-sightedness in a leader. At the same time, the lecture was deeply thought provoking, analytical and reflective.

Next, Professor Mathew touched upon the topic of the “Virus” that affects us, namely the paradigms that affects us. A paradigm is anything that dictates our behaviour. He reflected on the crucial role our conditionings have on our psyche in determining our vibrations and its resultant causative effect. He also enumerated the differences between the conscious mind and the sub- conscious mind and the six factors that overrides our conscious mind namely Perception, reason, memory, will, intuition and imagination and how internalizing an idea becomes a habitual action leading on to a particular result. In addition, Professor Mathew also focussed on how the paradigms could be altered through constant affirmative and positive reiteration; “to change something one needs to build a new model that makes existing model obsolete. “Further he touched upon Inductive reasoning (Conscious mind) and Deductive reasoning (Subconscious mind) explaining how actions propelled by



particular thoughts give forth the particular result. Thus it could be surmised that the thinking mind had the power to oust negative and unwanted thoughts through constant conscious effort. The talk concluded with Professor Mathew highlighting the true and unsullied essence of a person's personality i.e., the Spiritual side and the phenomenal untapped power of the human mind to manifest and materialize the desired and positive outcomes of one's life.

The session concluded with the formal vote of thanks given by Dr. J. Priya and the handing over of the memento to the Resorce person by the Head of the Department, Dr.Kavitha Desai.
