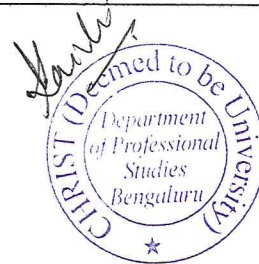
Summary of the Activity: (Highlights)
